Our Mission:

Highly skilled, efficient response to medical, ambulance, and fire emergencies, while working with our community to prevent, and prepare for, the next emergency.



REHAB

Canby Fire's active Rehab group responds to various incidents, including fires. This group aids our firefighters, both volunteer and career, by providing food and water as well as monitoring vital signs

CHAPLAINS

Our Chaplains respond on scene when they are needed to support families, our first responders, and patients. Being a Chaplain is a vital role to fill.



AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS

Licensed amateur radio operators that are willing to participate in the District's already established radio operator's group. This group activates in times of large-scale emergencies and disasters.



NEIGHBORHOOD EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM (NERT)

As trained and organized teams within the Fire District, NERT members receive training from Canby Fire for manmade or natural disasters to assist Canby Fire in areas with need. Volunteers are trained in basic first aid/CPR, Incident Command, and minor search and rescue for a neighborhood situation. After initial training, members should attend 2 drills per year to exercise preparedness levels.

ADMINISTRATION

Our main office is occasionally in need of volunteers to help with basic office duties and coverage during high demand work times. High school students are able to earn volunteer credits/hours for their time. Non-credited time will be compensated.



WATER TENDER DRIVER

Volunteer firefighters that may be retired as firefighters that want to be apparatus operators for water tenders. Canby has two water tankers that carry 3000 gallons and 1800 gallons of water in areas without water already available. Required training is less than a full-time volunteer firefighter with reduced physical requirements.
