

## Fire Protection System Inspection, Testing & Maintenance

## **Electronic Reporting Requirements**

Fire protection systems within the Canby Fire District are required by the Oregon Fire Code to be inspected, tested, and maintained at regular intervals. The purpose of these inspections is to ensure the systems operate properly in the event of an incident, ensuring a safe environment by minimizing the risk to life and property loss.

The Canby Fire District has contracted with BRYCER, LLC to help manage the fire protections systems inspection, testing and maintenance documents. All contractors who perform inspection, testing and maintenance services of fire protection systems within the Canby Fire District are required to electronically submit all compliant and non-compliant reports to the department via www.thecomplianceengine.com

The following Fire Protections Systems are electronically tracked by Canby Fire District:

- Automatic Wet/Dry Fire Sprinkler Systems
- Fire Sprinkler Systems 3-Year and 5-year Periodic Services
- Fire Alarm Systems, to include Sensitivity Testing
- Commercial kitchen hood suppression systems
- Emergency Lighting and Exit Sign Annual Inspections
- Wet/Dry Standpipes and Pressure Reducing Valves (PRVs)
- Paint Spray Booth Dry Fire Suppression Systems
- Special Hazards Suppression/Clean-Agent Systems
- Active Smoke Control Systems
- Portable Fire Extinguishers
- Emergency Generators
- Fire pumps

Fire protection contractors are required to submit all inspection, testing, and maintenance results to Canby Fire District on behalf of their customers.
